### **TOP TIPS**

- 1. Talk to people you trust about the benefits of higher education, what may be important for you to consider as a care leaver and what is the best path for you.
- 2. You can contact a 'care education providers in West Yorkshire. They may meet you to answer questions and show

- 3. Check what financial support is offered by your local authority to care leavers who would like to go into higher education. Your personal advisor should be able to help you with this.
- 4. When applying for courses through UCAS tick the 'care leaver' box to ensure you have access to all the support on offer. This information will be treated in confidence, and will not affect the outcome of your application in any way.
